EXHIBIT "C"

Accompaniment to Government Resolution, General Department No. 3281/33, dated the 16th June, 1939.

Conditions regarding Mr. Podar's Donation for an Ayurvedic College and an Ayurvedic Hospital in the City of Bombay.

1. The Institution will consist of :-
  - (a) An Ayurvedic College, and
  - (b) An Ayurvedic Hospital.
  
2. The Ayurvedic College will be named as "RAMBILAS ANANDILAL PODAR COLLEGE" and the Hospital will be named as "MAHADEVI ANANDILAL PODAR HOSPITAL". These names shall not be changed even though the activities of the Institutions may be extended in future.
  
3. Mr. Ramesh A. Podar, on behalf of the Donors (hereinafter called the Donor) will undertake to construct two buildings with electric, water and gas fittings in the City of Bombay, one costing not more than Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lac and Fifty Thousand only), and the other costing not more than Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two Lacs only) for the housing of an Ayurvedic College and Hospital.
  
4. The objects of the Institutions shall be :-
  - (a) To promote and encourage the study of the Ayurvedic system of medicine and of the literature

pertaining thereto, to conduct examinations and grant diplomas;

- (b) To give treatment on Ayurvedic lines;
- (c) To carry on research in Ayurvedic line of treatment;
- (d) And to do such other things as will help the promotion and spread of Ayurvedic Sciences.

5. The land necessary for the construction of the buildings for the College, the Hospital and other purposes incidental thereto should be (place to be decided yet) within the City of Bombay and approved by the Donors.

6. In order to carry out the Scheme, the Government should undertake :-

- (a) To provide land at such places agreed upon between the Government and the Donors free of cost, and
- (b) To conduct and bear all the expenses of the College and the Hospital.

7. The lands, equipment, property and the management and control of both the College and the Hospital will be vested in the Government, and the Government shall pay all rates, charges,

assessment and expenses leviable in respect of the said Institutions.

8. An Advisory Council shall be formed consisting of five members as under :-

(a) Two members to be nominated by the Donors, their Successors, Nominee or Nominees from time to time.

(b) Three members (one official and two non-officials, all deeply interested in Ayurveda) to be nominated by the Government.

(c) Any vacancy or vacancies among the two members appointed by the Donors will be filled up by the Donors, their Successors, Nominee or Nominees.

(d) The Council will elect its own Chairman and its term of office will be five years at the end of which period fresh nominations will be made by the Donors and the Government.

9. The Hospital will provide accommodation for 75 beds at least.

10. The Heads of the Institutions shall be Ayurvedic Experts of Acknowledged repute.
