Sub:- Show Cause Notice for violation of Bio-Medical Waste (M&H) Rule, 1998 as Amended therein.
Ref: Office note submitted by SRO Mumbai -I vide no 180303FTS0093

Ministry of environment & forest ,Govt of india in exercise of the power conferred u/s 6,8,& 25 of Environment (Protection)Act,1986 has notified Biomedical (M & H)Rule,1998 ,as amended from time to time

WHEREAS, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board is the prescribed authority for enforcement of Biomedical Waste (M & H) Rule,1998, as amended time to time and is applicable to all health care establishment, AND WHEREAS, it is mandatory to all HCE's to obtain authorization under rule 8 of the said rule, by making application form 1 to M.P.C. Board.

AND WHEREAS, it was further obligatory on your part to provide adequate arrangement for treatment and disposal of BMW as per SHEDULE I and in compliance with the standards prescribed in SHEDULE V of said rules or send the BMW to Common Bio-medical Waste facility.

AND WHEREAS, it was obligatory on your part to submit online Annual report in Form-II (see rule 10)in the prescribed format by 31st January every year to include information about the categories & quantities of Biomedical waste Handled during the preceding year.

AND WHEREAS, after examining office record Sub Regional Officer, Mumbai-I submitted office note & reported that you have not submitted Annual report /Form-II in the prescribed format to this office till date.

AND WHEREAS, you have not taken effective steps to ensure compliance which shows negligent attitude towards implementation and management of Biomedical Waste (M & H) Rule,1998, ,as amended .

AND WHEREAS the board has taken a serious view of your wilful and continuous non-compliance of the said rules and has decided to give you the last opportunity before initiating legal action


